


## **Press Release**

Rome, April 7, 2025 - This year too, the appointment with the <u>Course on Exorcism and the Prayer of Liberation</u>, organized by the **Sacerdos Institute** of the Pontifical Athenaeum Regina Apostolorum (APRA) and the **GRIS** (Group for Research and Socio-Religious Information), returns.

The Course, unique worldwide for its scientific-interdisciplinary approach, proposes careful and multidisciplinary academic research in response to current needs.

"We are pleased to organize, also and above all in the Jubilee Year and, for the 19th year, this increasingly widespread interdisciplinary course of international interest. In fact, it is increasingly important and urgent to guarantee adequate training also in this area, which is still often subject to narrow views," says **Prof. P. Edward Mc Namara LC, Director of the Sacerdos Institute**, and continues "...There is growing interest and involvement also from the laity in this Ministry, and for this year we will give space to it thanks to the participation of Prof. Mary Healy, who will explore some aspects in depth."

**Prof. Mary Healy adds** in this regard: "I am thrilled to be speaking on this topic at the Course on Exorcism and Deliverance. The ministry of exorcism has always been one of the most important ways the Church cares for those oppressed by Satan, who are among his least understood and most marginalized children. Beginning with Vatican II, the Church has rediscovered a complementary truth as old as the Gospel: all the baptized in Christ, clergy and laity, are given authority over the enemy in the name of Christ."
