PRESENTATION

The Joint Diploma in "Women and the Church" is an academic program promoted by several Pontifical institutions to enhance the role of women in the mission of the Church, fostering collaboration and synodality, overcoming cultural barriers, and promoting the contribution of women in decisionmaking processes within the Church and beyond.

AUDIENCE

The course is aimed at priests, religious men and women, and laypeople (men and women) involved in ecclesial settings at curial, diocesan, academic levels or in formative roles in various forms of consecrated or associative life

PROGRAM

The course is structured around three dynamics: Listening to understand the challenges of the female condition in the Church.

Discerning to identify their causes and guide action. Acting to promote the conversion and renewal of the Church, inspired by the Second Vatican Council. The program is divided into three thematic modules: Socio-Historical, Anthropological and **Ecclesiological**

STRUCTURE

Mode: Online

Methodology: Handouts and video lectures, interactive lessons, practical exercises and workshops, discussion moments, roundtables, and a final exam.
