## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Academic degree that allows access to university studies in the country of origin.

## STRUCTURE

The **three-year degree** is a First Cycle degree that lasts 3 years (180 ECTS) and gives access to theological studies and the Licentiate in Philosophy.

The **two-year degree** in Philosophy lasts 2 years (120 ECTS) and does not lead to a university degree, but gives access to the Baccalaureate in Theology.

**CREDITS:** Three-year degree 180 ECTS  
Two-year core Philosophy studies 120 ECTS

### 1<sup>st</sup> YEAR

Logic, Philosophy of Knowledge, Philosophy of Science, Philosophy of Nature, History of Ancient Philosophy, History of Medieval Philosophy.

#### Related disciplines

Modern language, Seminar of your choice.

### 2<sup>nd</sup> YEAR

#### Fundamental disciplines

Metaphysics, Philosophical Theology, Philosophy of Man, Moral Philosophy, History of Modern Philosophy, History of contemporary philosophy.

#### Related disciplines

Philosophical Latin, Course and Seminar of your choice.

### 3<sup>rd</sup> YEAR

#### Fundamental disciplines

Formal and Applied Logic, Philosophical Anthropology, Political Philosophy, Phenomenology and Philosophy of Religion, Philosophy of Language, Aesthetics, History of Hermeneutic and Analytical Philosophy.

#### Related disciplines

Faith and reason, Course and Seminar of your choice, synthesis seminar. Bachelor's thesis and comprehensive Exam.
