## EXPERIENTIAL WORKSHOP «WOMEN AND CHURCH»

The experiential laboratory will allow each participant the opportunity to confront himself and others and to elaborate and enhance aspects of himself less explored on the subject of the course with the aim of:

- facilitating the perception of the experience of one's own masculinity or femininity, of one's own way of being a woman/man and of one's potential [to listen],
- provoking vital confrontation with the content received [to discern],
- customizing and form a new way of relating and collaborating as a woman or man for-with-in Christ in the Church [to act].

In this experiential workshop, a space for sharing and research, in function of these objectives we will resort to introspection, personal exploration and openness to others, through sharing and mediation of the group, narration, Storytelling, effective communication, the deepening of artistic expression with a view to personal and group well-being and enrichment.

## Topics

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### *First meeting*

1. Man / Woman in my experience; gender roles and generations; the collective imagination.
2. Vocation-mission- female role, the essence of women.

### *Second meeting*

3. Women and the Church, what relationship? Problematic 'ecclesial' attitudes for modern women.
4. Collaboration between men and women in the Church. Understanding and implementation,

### *Third meeting*

5. Ecclesial commitment: a) to discover and welcome femininity in the Church; b) to train women in the feminine gift of self.
6. Group closing statement: "Women and the Church. Our commitment"

## Evaluation

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1. Collection of group account
2. Qualitative analysis of some of the group texts
3. Observation and peer review of personal work
4. Final report
