PRESENTATION

The Faculty of Philosophy of the Ateneo Pontificio Regina Apostolorum offers a unique blend of **faith and reason, culture and science**, proposing to **rigorous rational thought** the precious contribution of the **Christian vision** of the world.

WHO SHOULD APPLY?

- **People interested** in obtaining a systematic and organic training in **Christian philosophy**, which enables them to **confront** the present **culture**.
- **Seminarians, Religious men and women, Lay people** who aspire to enrol in the baccalaureate of Theology or Licentiate of Philosophy in an ecclesiastical faculty.

The Faculty promotes the possibility of **easy integration** also for access to civil master's faculties for teaching purposes.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To be admitted to the Faculty of Philosophy it's necessary to be in possession of the academic degree that allows access to higher university studies in the country of origin.

For those who are not native Italian speakers, is required a knowledge of the Italian language sufficient for university studies.

STRUCTURE

Three-year degree: three-year studies offer the insights and exercises to achieve the objectives of a First Cycle university degree (Baccalaureate) according to the European Higher Education Area (EHEA). In addition, they offer the prerequisites for access to ecclesiastical theological studies. The First Cycle lasts three years and offers a total of **180 ECTS**.

Two-year degree: in agreement with the Faculty of Theology, the Faculty of Philosophy offers the two-year course set by the Holy See required for admission to the Baccalaureate (First Cycle) in Theology, but does not grant a university degree as long as the necessary integrative studies are not carried out later. The Philosophical Biennium offers a total of **120 ECTS**.

Formal and Applied Logic, Philosophical Anthropology, Political Philosophy, Phenomenology and Philosophy of Religion, Philosophy of Language, Aesthetics, History of Hermeneutic and Analytical Philosophy.

Related disciplines

Faith and reason, Course and Seminar of your choice, synthesis seminar, Bachelor's thesis and overall Exam.
