PRESENTATION

The Faculty offers **two Licentiate programs** both with the aim of achieving a **personal, specialized, in-depth** and **scientific theological synthesis** in the chosen field. With a maximum limit of 20 students for each specialization, our programs favor the active role of students in courses and seminars, the personalized attention of the teaching staff and the creation of an engaging academic community.


ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Bachelor's in Theology or Philosophical-Theological Sexennium in a Seminary or other approved Higher Institute.

TRAINING OBJECTIVES

- **Achieve** a personal theological synthesis in one's specialization;
- **Acquire** specific preparation in a particular field;
- **Develop** the ability to do theological research;
- **Grow** in communication skills;
- **Prepare** for teaching;
- **Experience** the universality of the Church in the Roman formative context.

LICENTIATE IN DOGMATIC THEOLOGY

The program develops a comprehensive, deep and systematic knowledge of dogmatic theology with expertise in specific areas.

Who should apply?

Whoever intends to transmit a well-ordered knowledge of the faith in church leadership positions, major seminaries or equivalent schools, and those who wish to proceed with a Doctor's degree.

Structure

The program covers the following areas:

1. Foundations of Theology and Fundamental Theology;
2. Trinitarian Theology and Christology;
3. Creation and Theological Anthropology;
4. Ecclesiology and Ecumenism;
5. Liturgical and Sacramental Theology.

Courses and Seminars

- 3 required courses in historical theology;
- 5 required courses in systematic theology, (one for each of the areas indicated above);
- 8 elective seminars, which privilege the reading and commentary of great works of theology;
- 1 course of research methodology;
- 1 course of pedagogy.

LICENTIATE IN SPIRITUAL THEOLOGY

The program emphasizes the mystery of Christ and of the Church at the center of the spiritual life nurtured by the prayerful reading of Sacred Scripture and modeled on the examples of the Saints.

Who should apply?

Whoever intends to apply the theoretical and practical knowledge of spiritual theology as spiritual directors or directors of spiritual exercises, future teachers in major seminaries or equivalent schools, and those who wish to proceed with a Doctor's degree.

Structure

The program prioritizes direct contact with the works of the great teachers and schools of Christian spirituality.

Courses and Seminars

- 2 courses in the history of spiritual theology and spirituality;
- 6 required courses;
- 2 elective courses;
- 6 elective seminars;
- 1 course of methodology;
- 1 course of pedagogy.

Each course of study is completed with the dissertation and the overall examination.
